Topic: Partnering for the effective delivery of logistics support

PRESENTATION: Partnering for the effective delivery of logistics support

The Australian Defence Force (ADF) is currently conducting operations throughout the world. Effective supply chain support is critical to operational success. Joint Logistics Group (JLG) is responsible for planning and managing support to ADF operations, strategic logistics functions and the operation of the ADF physical logistics network. The ADF requires the ability to design, constitute, decouple and reconstitute supply chains rapidly to meet often unforeseen requirements utilising global distribution modes and nodes. Critical to the success of ADF operations is successful partnering relationships with service providers and industry. This presentation will show how partnering is key to ADF operations by describing the range of support to current operations; the different strategies employed depending on the strategic circumstances; and the challenges of designing and operating military supply chains.

PRESENTER: Major General Grant Cavenagh, Commander Joint Logistics Group, Department of Defence

Major-General Grant Cavenagh is the Commander, Joint Logistics (CJLOG). Throughout his career, he has had a wide range of regimental logistics postings, including Director General, Land Manoeuvre Systems in the Defence Materiel Organisation; Director Mobility Systems in Support Command; Commander Force Logistic Support Group and Logistic Component Commander for the International Force East Timor; Commanding Officer 2nd Field Logistic Battalion and Commanding Officer of 10 Force Support Battalion. He is a Master Project Director within the Australian Institute of Project Management, a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Management and a Graduate of the Australian Institute of Company Directors. In 1999 Major-General Cavenagh was awarded the Order of Australia for his services to logistics and in 2000 he was awarded a Commendation for Distinguished Service as the Commander, Force Logistic Support Group, International Force East Timor.
