The Australian Logistics Council has over seventy members, all of whom are senior leaders from various parts of the supply chain and from all States and Territories including logistics customers, major logistics providers, CEO's or Chairs of industry associations and peak bodies, the Chairs of the State-based Freight Councils (who importantly represent small and medium enterprises on the ALC), senior government officials and regulators and industry specialists. Our focus is to ensure that the logistics system in Australia is ready to handle the rapidly growing freight task, a task that is forecast to double by 2015.

The Council will meet three times in 2007 and leads the implementation of the Australian Logistics Industry Strategy at the national level. ALC is also developing a new National Strategy for Transport & Logistics 2008-2010 that will guide regulation, investment and planning.

The Council exists to improve the 'efficiency in delivery' of Australian logistics. Our 2007 Position Statements are enclosed. They focus on:

- The Right Infrastructure
- Capable People
- Streamlined Rules and Regulations, and
- Understanding the Future of Transport and Logistics

Membership is by invitation and, while there are no membership fees, members are asked to ensure that their status as members is included in their bios and are invited and encouraged to provide financial support each year. ALC is jointly funded by industry, State and Commonwealth Governments. Industry provides the majority of funds while the Australian Government is the single biggest supporter. Supporter levels are also enclosed.
