MAJOR CLIENT ENGAGEMENTS

At the start of 2008, Chandler Macleod was added to the panel of suppliers for a leading retail client, supplying permanent showroom, counter and driving staff. Our role has since expanded to include the supply of a full range of roles, including warehouse staff, temporary drivers, IT&T staff and accounting and graduate recruitment services. We now supply to over 100 of the client's sites nationwide, with a \$6m annual value of business for all roles.

In April 2009, we signed a Preferred Supplier Agreement with a client who operates a national logistics business. Since the start of the agreement, we have supplied a full range of staff to the client, including all categories of drivers, pick packers, relabelers and container unloaders. The overall value of the agreement is estimated at between \$3-5m per year.
